Reference is made to your request for a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' jurisdictional determination on property located in Sections 44 & 45, T. 8 S., R. 12 E., and Sections 55, 12, and 38, T. 8 S., R. 11 E., St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana (enclosed map). Specifically, this property is identified as squares 242, 257, 294, 310, 327, and 340 in the Town of Mandeville.

Based on review of recent maps, aerial photography, soils data, and information provided with your request, we have determined that part of the property is wetland and subject to Corps' jurisdiction. The approximate limit of the wetland is designated in red on the map. A Department of the Army (DA) Permit under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act will be required prior to the deposition or redistribution of dredged or fill material in this wetland.

You are advised that this determination is valid for a period of five years from the date of this letter unless new information warrants revision of the delineation before the expiration date.
